Basic introduction of US equipment, EFAST exams, Aorta exams, and the use of US to assist in vascular access.

Objectives

- Discuss and demonstrate clinical applications of the eFAST examination in the patient with blunt/penetrating torso trauma.
- Discuss and demonstrate clinical applications of bed-side ultrasound in the patient with hypotension of unknown etiology.
- Discuss and demonstrate clinical applications of aorta ultrasound in the patient with suspected ruptured AAA

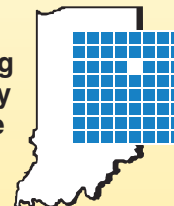
